## **LESSON IDEA: A BIG GROWING HEART**

- Age: from age 6
- Learning area: social-emotional development, identity
- Preparation time: 5 min
- Duration: 30 min

### WHAT DO YOU NEED?

- A3 drawing paper
- Pencils
- Glossy paint (like Creall Gloss)
- Glitter paint (like Creall Glitter)
- Brushes, for example, Gussow brushes or Creall Trixi brush

### WHAT WILL YOU BE DOING?

Make a heart for a family member or friend. Write a wish for this person at the back.



### STEP 1

Do you know what it means if someone has a place in your heart? Who has a place in your heart? What would you wish for this person?



#### STEP 2

Let the children draw a heart in the middle of the drawing paper. Make sure that they leave plenty of space around the heart. The pupils can then choose a colour glossy paint with which they will be painting the heart.





### STEP 3

Choose a different colour and draw a line around the contours of the heart with it. Choose another colour and repeat. The heart is getting bigger!

When the heart is big enough, you can decorate it with glitter paint.



### STEP 4

When your work of art has dried up, turn it around. Write down your wish for the person that has a place in your heart, at the back.
