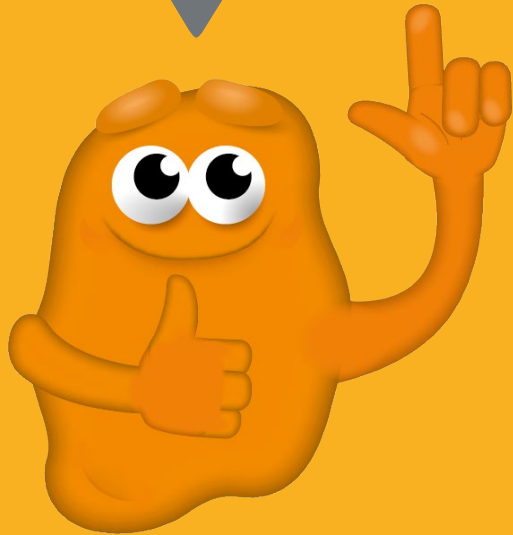

A FIELD FULL OF FLOWERS

WHAT DO YOU NEED?

- Large sheets of white paper
- Watercolour like Creall Tint
- Poster paint like Creall Basic color
- Brushes like the Creall Trixi brush
- Small white paper circles
- Small scissors
- Cotton swabs
- Glue
- Wrapping paper

WHAT WILL YOU BE DOING?

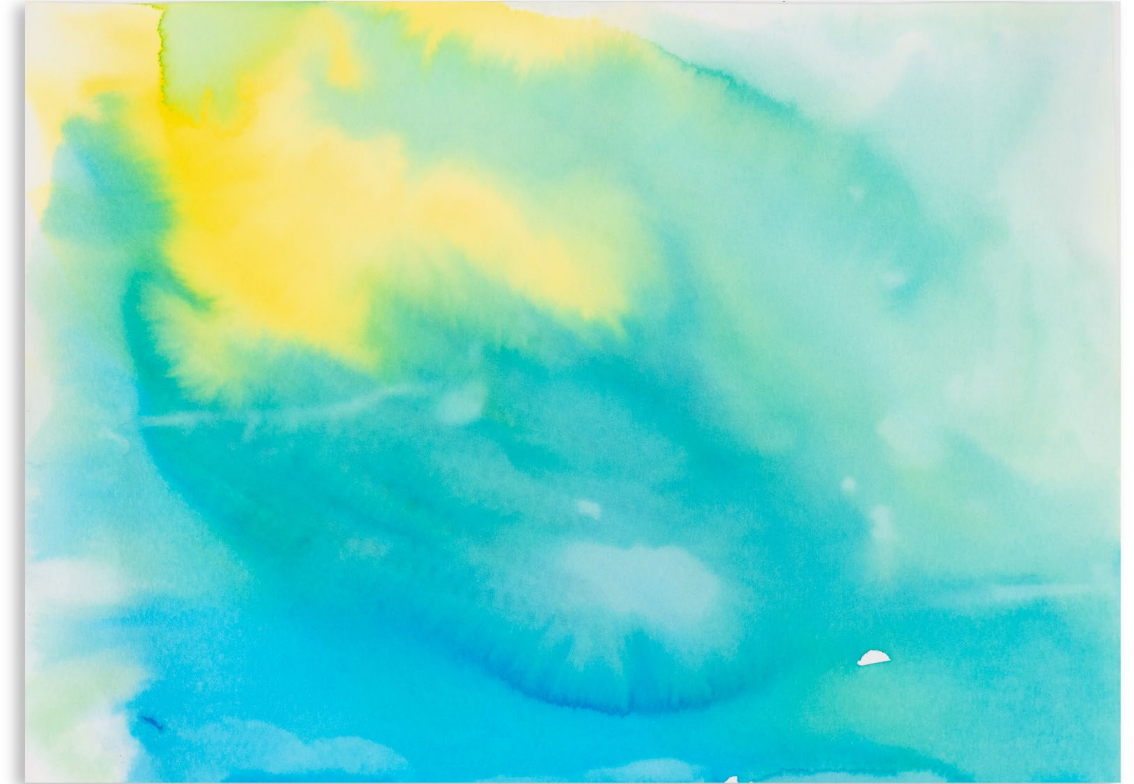
Make a field full of flowers with some of your classmates.



A FIELD FULL OF FLOWERS

STEP 1

Together with the children in your group you will be painting a field full of flowers with watercolours. It's not a problem if the colours blend together a bit.



A FIELD FULL OF FLOWERS

STEP 2

Take a cotton swab and dip that into the paint. Dab the small circular papers with the cotton swabs until it is completely full. These are the hearts of the flowers.

STEP 3

Cut the petals from the gift wrapping. Stick the hearts and petals with glue on the painted sheet of paper. The petals are allowed to overlap a bit.

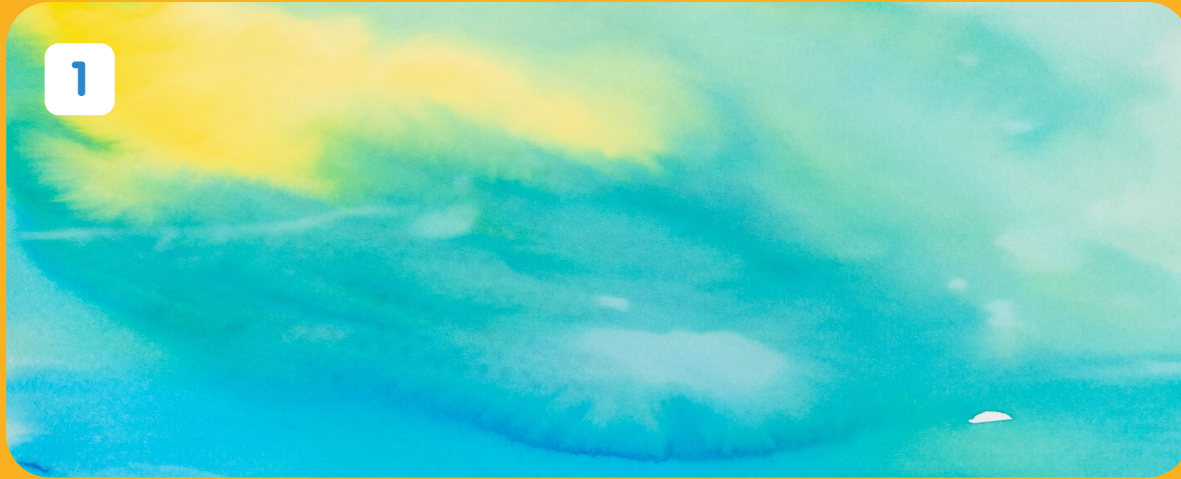
STEP 4
