LESSON PLAN: THE BALL PIT

- Age: from age 4
- Learning area: math
- Preparation time: 5 min
- Duration: 30 min




WHAT DO YOU NEED?

- A3 drawing paper
- Finger paint (like Creall Fingerpaint)
- Balls
- Tape

WHAT WILL YOU BE DOING?

We will make a ball pit with finger paint and fill this up with balls of various colours. After that, we are going to count the balls.



START WITH A GAME

First, we will do a game. Sit in a square on the floor to form a 'ball pit'. Roll the ball towards each other and make sure the ball cannot escape.






STEP 1

We will now be sitting at the table in groups. Stick the paper to the table. Paint a square with your fingers. This is the ball pit.


Each child will paint another square around the first square, but in a different colour



STEP 2

Paint little balls in the ball pit by making small circular movements with your finger. Make balls in different colours!


Attention: the balls should not touch each other!





STEP 3

We will fill up the entire pit with the little balls.






STEP 4

Count the various balls. How many red balls are there? And how many blue ones or yellow ones?
