

MATERIALS

- A3 drawing paper
- Drawing pencils such as Creall Maxi
- Poster paint such as Creall Basic colour
- Brushes such as Creall Gussow
- Photos of cupcakes from different perspectives

LEARNING OBJECTIVE

Playfully explore different possibilities of space (suggestion) when drawing. Write a short text (here: invitation).

Tip: bake cupcakes or take them with you so they can be viewed from different perspectives.



CUPCAKE PARTY!

Show the photos and discuss how the perspective changes from various angles. Let the students search for basic shapes, such as ovals, in the photos.

Next, every student draws the cupcakes on the drawing paper. They can vary based on the size of the cupcakes, the location of the cupcakes and the perspective. This creates the suggestion of space in the drawing.

The students paint the cupcakes and decorate these according to their own insights.

When the cupcakes are dried, the students write or paint a short text on the back in which they invite friends to their cupcake party.
