MATERIALS

- Soft clay like Creall Ultra soft
- Autumn table or natural materials like acorns, chestnuts, leaves, fungi, etc.

LEARNING OBJECTIVE

Learn about some of the most common plants in the children's own environment with their names and some properties and features. Realise that plants are food for both animals and humans.





FIND THE DIFFERENCE: AUTUMN!



Inspect the autumn table or the natural materials together with the children. Discuss what you see. What shapes and colours do the children see? What can the animals (or people) eat? Do the children know the names of the material?

The children choose one or more objects. They will make a clay object of that. They can also take the object with them to their table and use it as an example.



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When all the objects are ready, the children can compare them with the clay works. Do they look anything like the real object? Why so or why not?
