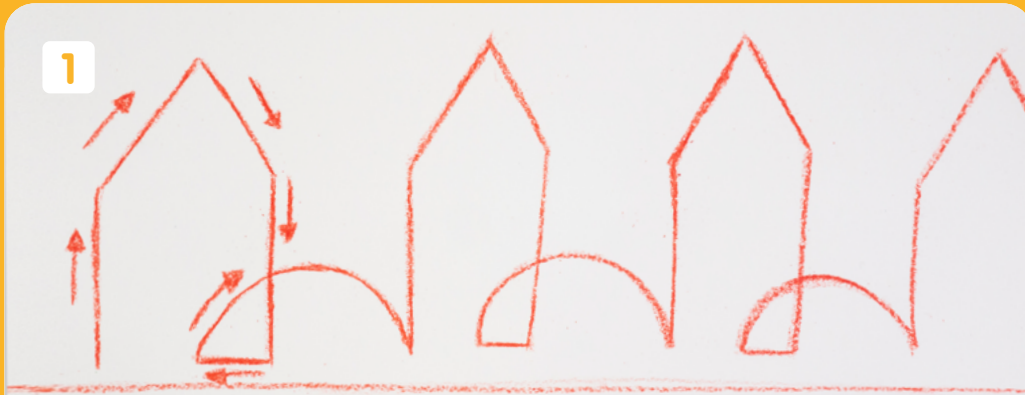
- A3 drawing paper

1 Show the pupils how they can draw a house with one continuous line. Let the pupils copy the movement in the air.

Stick the drawing papers to the tables. Let the children draw a line on the paper from left to right with a crayon. This is the horizon.

Let the pupils draw several houses with a crayon while they say the sentence. Then they will start painting the houses with poster paint.
