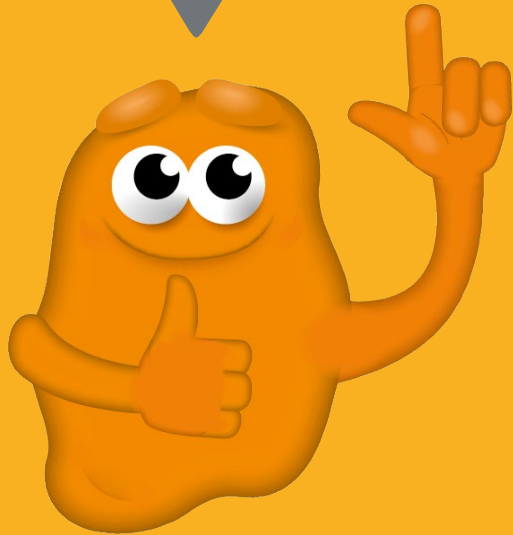

LESSON PLAN: MIXING COLOURS - SECONDARY

- Learning area: art & design
- Preparation time: 5 minutes

MIXING COLOURS - SECONDARY

WHAT DO YOU NEED?

- Poster paint such as Creall Eco color
- Colouring picture of a fox
- Brushes such as Creall Kids brush balloon
- Image of a fox

WHAT WILL YOU BE DOING?

You mix the colour orange and paint a fox.



MIXING COLOURS - SECONDARY

STEP 1

Take a good look at the image of the fox.
Where does the fox live? What does it eat?
Does it have hair, wool or feathers?
And what colours can you discover?

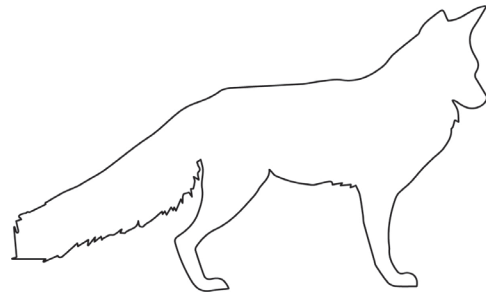


MIXING COLOURS - SECONDARY

STEP 2

The teacher will hand out colouring pictures.

Now you can make the orange paint. Add a little red to a dollop of yellow paint. Mix it thoroughly, You have now made orange yourself. Use it to paint the fox.



MIXING COLOURS - SECONDARY

STEP 3

Paint the environment of the fox. You can choose what you paint around the fox.

Would you like to add colours for this?

Mixing blue and yellow will make green. Red and blue make purple.

STEP 4

Is your painting finished? Look at the paintings of your classmates together.
Which colours can you detect on them?



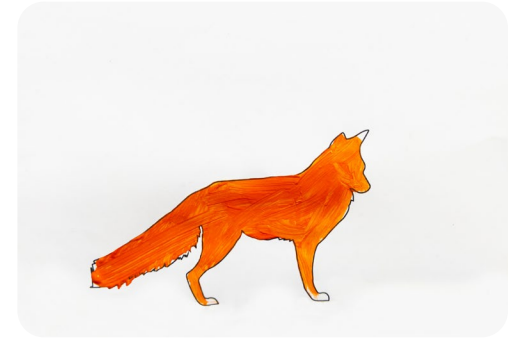
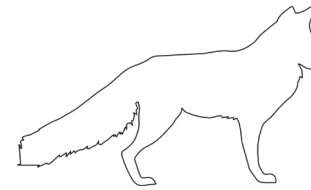
