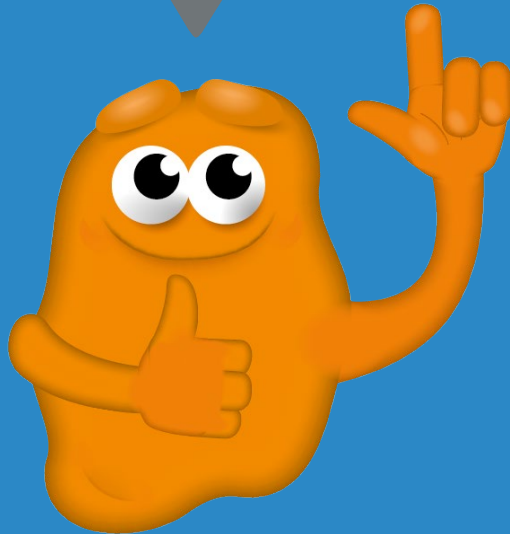

LESSON PLAN: PICTURE WITH MY STORY

- Age: from age 10
- Learning area: English, artistic orientation
- Preparation time: 5 minutes
- Duration: 2 x 60 minutes

PICTURE WITH MY STORY

WHAT DO YOU NEED?

- Lined A4 paper
- A4 paper
- Camera
- Printer
- Air-drying clay like Creall Do & dry
- Opaque gouache paint like Creall Color+
- Paper fastener
- Hole puncher

WHAT WILL YOU BE DOING?

You think of and write a story. Next, you will use clay to make a cover for your story.



PICTURE WITH MY STORY

STEP 1

Write a nice story about the theme. You can decide if it will be an exciting, funny or fantasy story.

If you want, you can also write a draft first.



PICTURE WITH MY STORY

STEP 2

Is your story finished? Then you will sculpt something that fits your story and that will make other children want to read your story.

Let your clay art dry.



PICTURE WITH MY STORY

STEP 3

Once your artwork is dry, you can paint it with gouache. Is your paint dry? Take a picture of your artwork.



PICTURE WITH MY STORY

STEP 4

Print the picture on an empty sheet of A4 paper: this will be the cover of your story. Put your story and the cover in a paper fastener.

Next, read a classmate's story. Did you like the story? What did you like about it?
