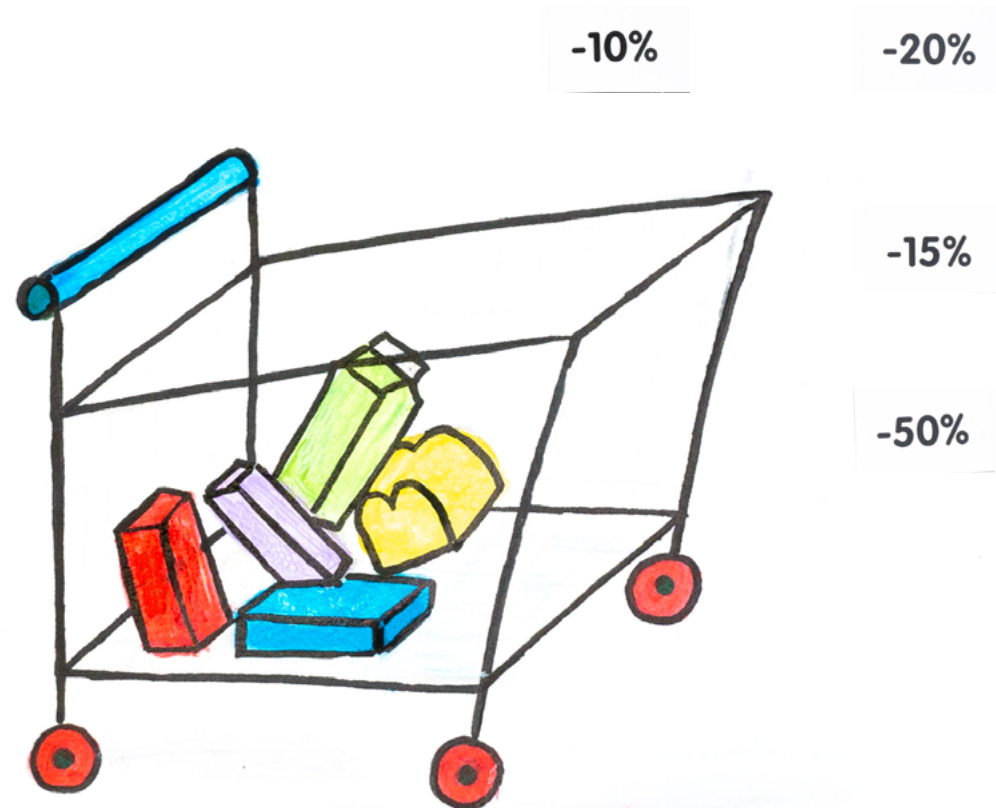


MATERIALS

LEARNING OBJECTIVE

Practising calculations with percentages by calculating discounts.



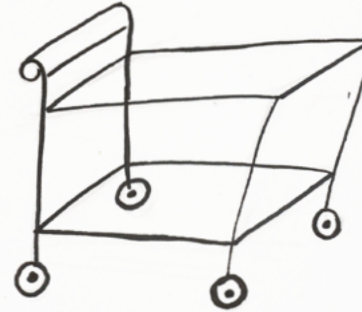

Put together a list of products and give each product a price and a discount percentage. Copy the list and hand it out in the classroom or write it down on the board.

2



Let the pupils draw a shopping cart in perspective on the paper. Subsequently, they can choose several products from the list and draw them (also in perspective) inside the shopping cart.

Let the children paint the shopping cart and the products with the gloss paint. After the paint has dried, the children can write down the names of the products on it.

After that, let the pupils calculate the new prices of the products in their shopping cart and add it all up. Check together with the pupils if their calculations are correct.
