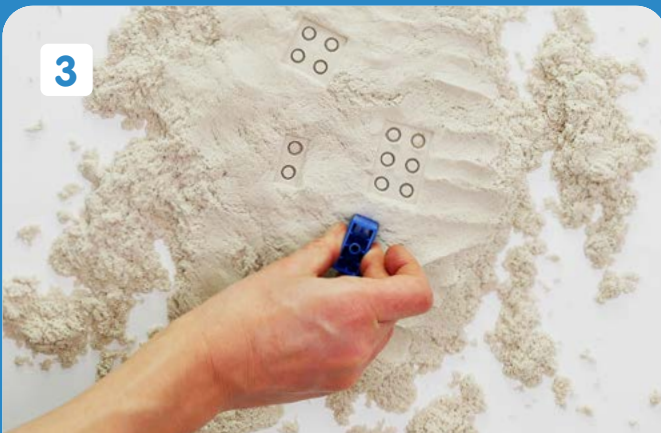
For this lesson, it is encouraged to use sand and as many things as possible with fun and different textures.

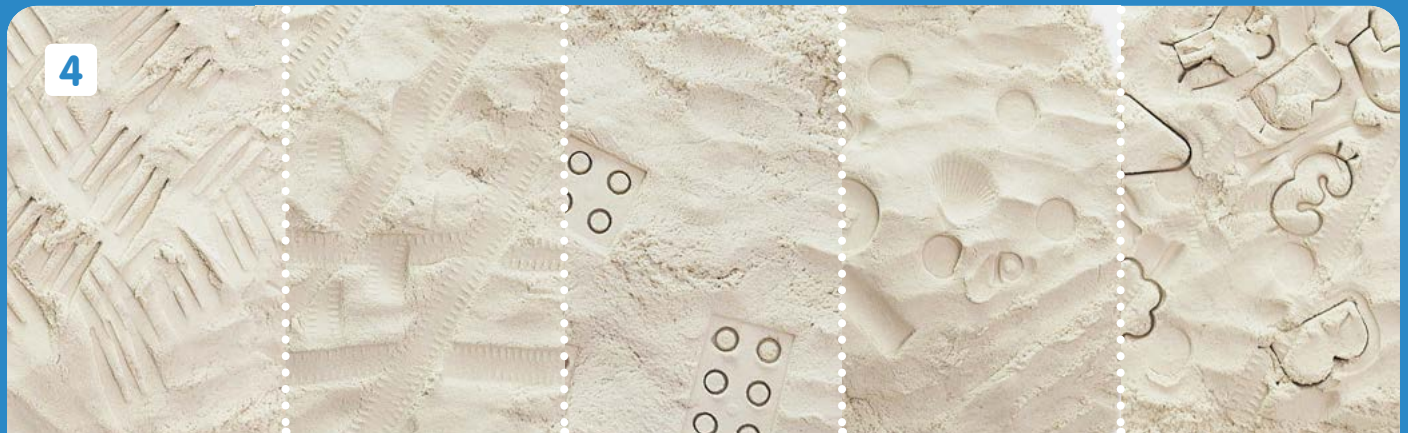
Let the children create textures in the sand.
