

### **LESSON PLAN: THE COLOUR WHEEL**

- Age: from age 8
- Learning area: art & design
- Preparation time: 5 minutes
- Duration: 45 minutes



### WHAT DO YOU NEED?

- Poster paint such as Creall Eco color
- Colouring picture of a fox
- Brushes such as Creall Trixi brush

#### WHAT WILL YOU DO?

You choose a colour combination and paint a fox.











#### **STEP 1**

Are you already familiar with the colour circle? This circle will help you to make different colour combinations. Examples of colour combinations are:

Monochrome colours: different tints of one colour.

Analogue colours: a combination of 2 or more colours that are next to each other in the colour circle.

Complementary colours: colours that are opposite each other in the colour circle.

monochrome colours




complementary colours

#### STEP 2

Choose one colour combination for your painting. Get or mix the colours you need for it.

Do you want to make monochrome colours? Then mix more and more black or white with your basic colour. This way you will get different tints of one colour. This is what we call monochrome colours.



### **STEP 3**

The teacher will give you a colouring picture. Paint the fox and its surroundings. Decide yourself what the surroundings of the fox look like.



### **STEP 4**


Is your painting finished? Then look at the paintings of your classmates together. Which colour combinations can you notice?
