LEARNING OBJECTIVE

Investigating the different possibilities of colour.

Experimenting with the image aspect colour, such as the colour wheel, colour contrasts and colour combinations.

Arranging and classifying animals into main groups and species. Example: the fox.



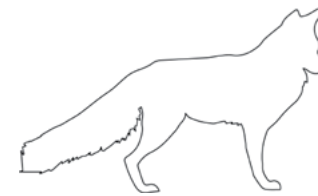
THE COLOUR WHEEL

Discuss the fox. What kind of animal is it? How does that show? Show the colour wheel and discuss the different colour combinations, such as monochrome, analogue and complementary colours.

Give every pupil a colouring picture of the fox. Allow the pupils to choose one colour combination and let them mix the necessary colours for it.

Using the mixed colours they paint the fox and its habitat. In doing this, they play with the colour combination that they chose.

When the foxes are finished, you discuss the paintings. Which colour combinations can the pupils notice?
