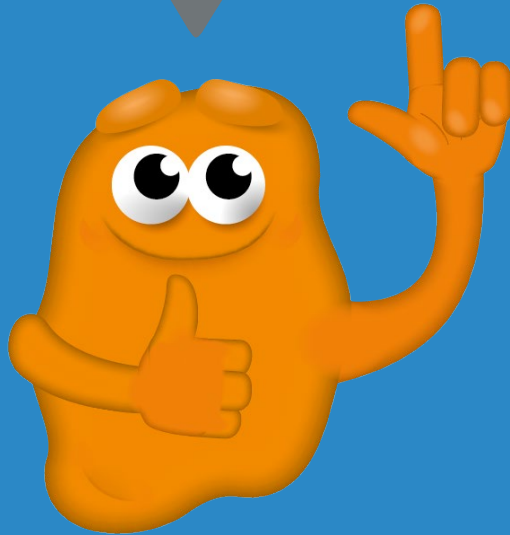

- Duration: 60 minutes

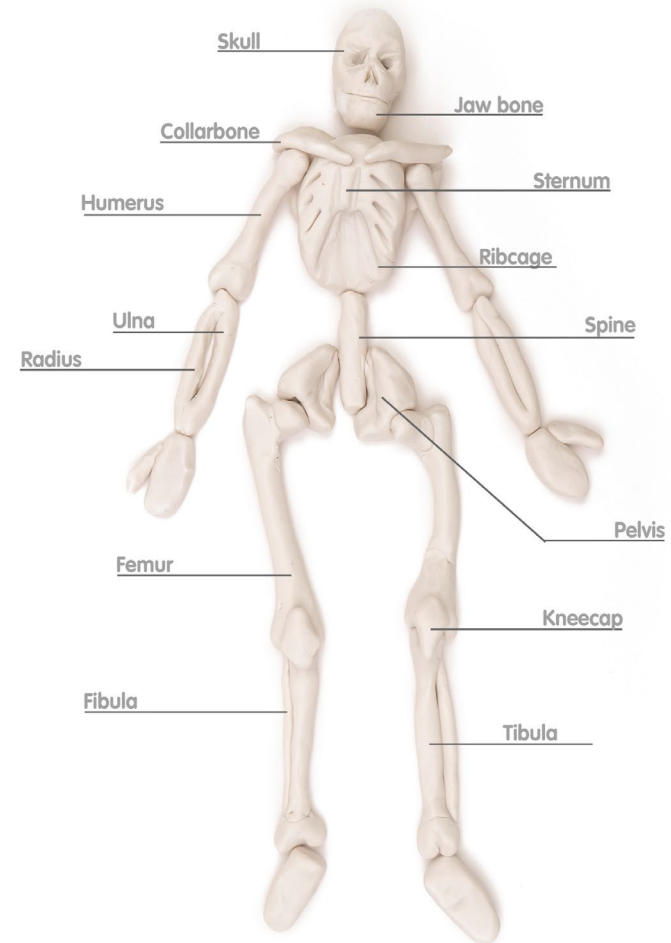
THE HUMAN SKELETON

WHAT DO YOU NEED?

- Clay that stays soft like Creall Therm soft
- Clay tools like Creall Spatulas
- A3 paper
- Image of the human skeleton

You will sculpt a skeleton out of clay.

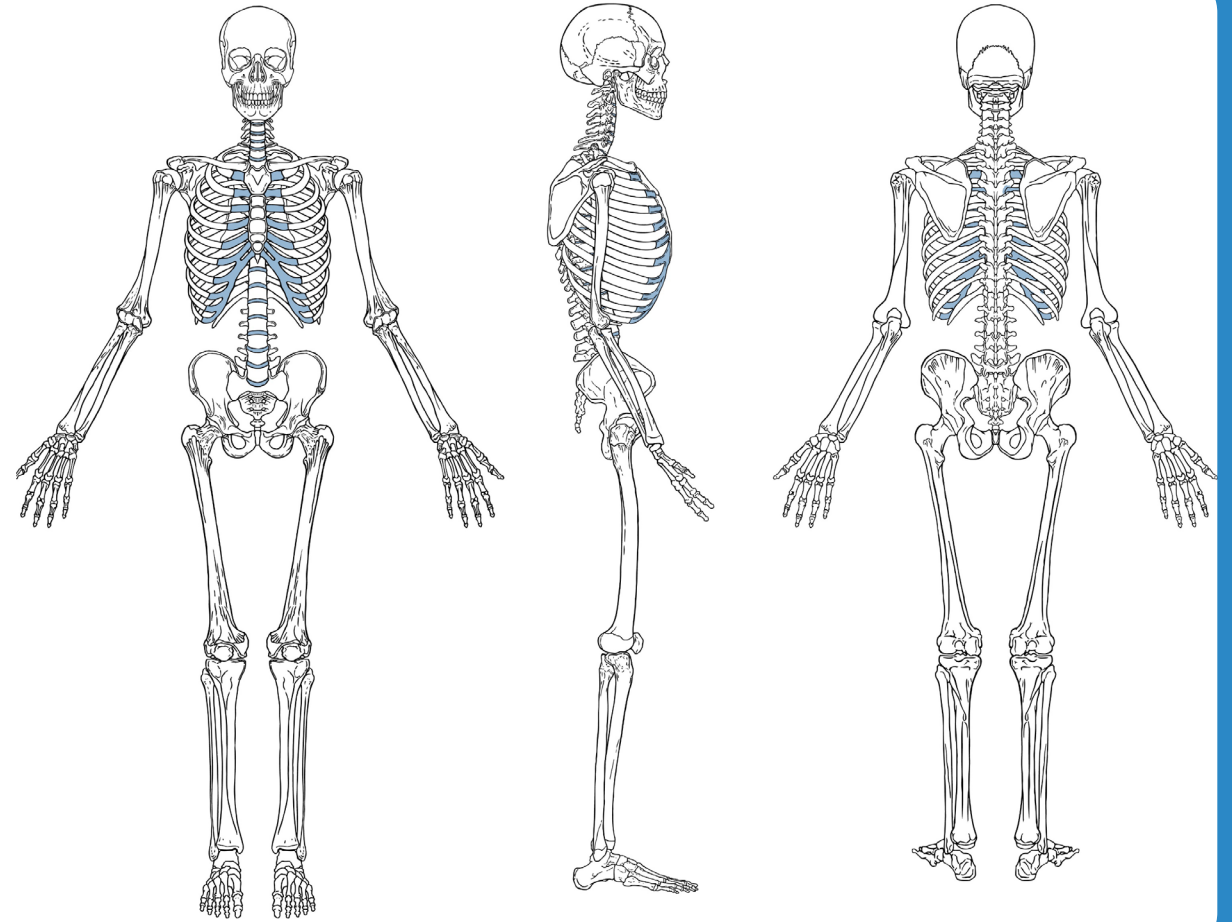


THE HUMAN SKELETON

STEP 1

Take a look at the human skeleton. Can you name a few bones? What are the tasks of your bones?

Try to feel your own bones. Can you feel your collarbone? Or your knee cap?

STEP 2

Sculpt the components of the skeleton out of clay. It does not have to match the picture exactly.

STEP 3

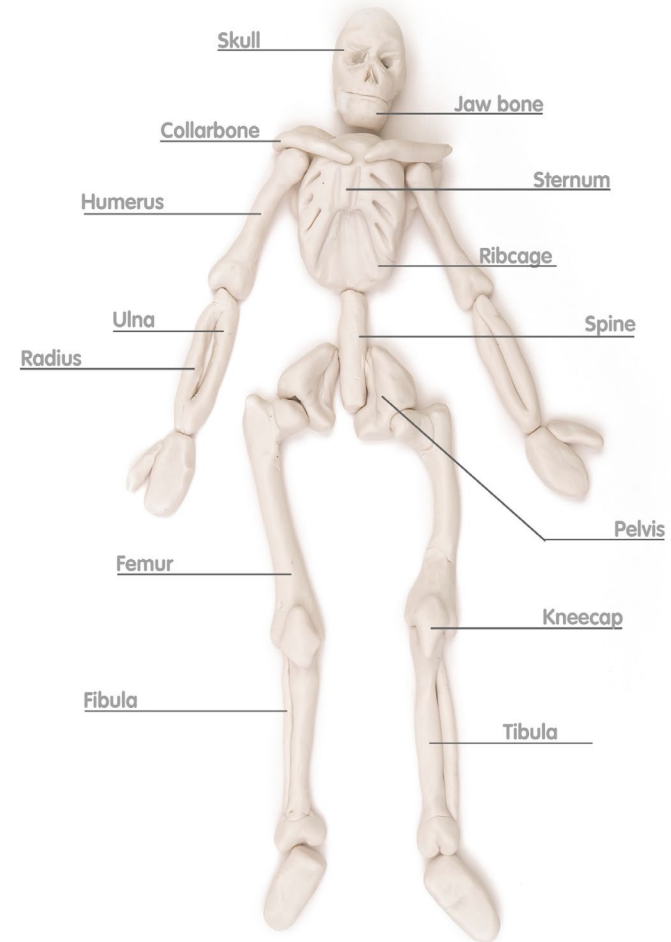
Put the components on the paper in the correct order. Make sure to pay attention to where the bones should fit together.

STEP 4

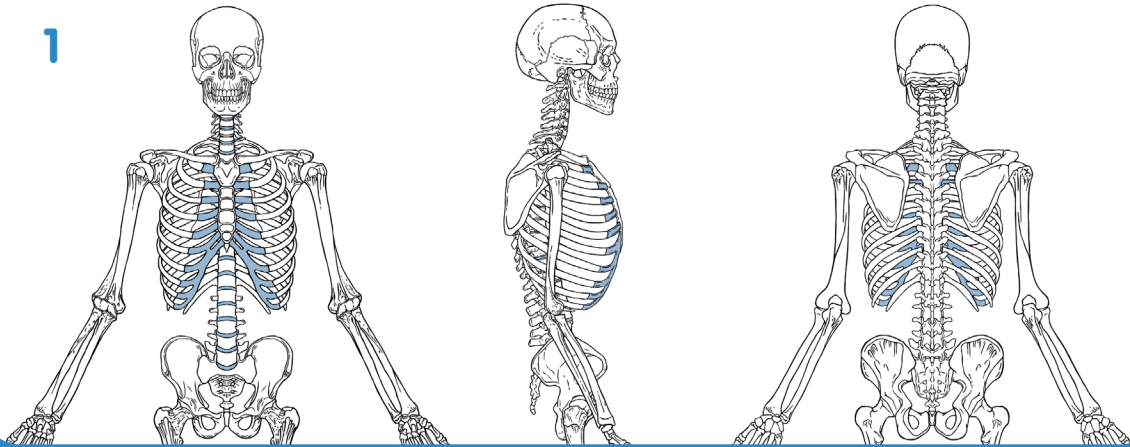
Is your skeleton in place? Then write the names of the bones down next to the bones.

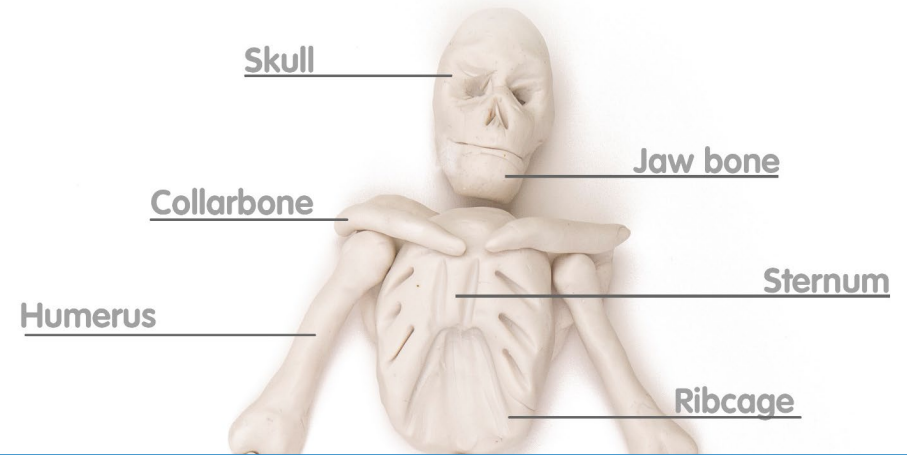
