### **LESSON PLAN: VOLCANO**

Age: from age 10

Learning area: world studies, geography

Preparation time: 10 minutes

Duration: 60 minutes

#### WHAT DO YOU NEED?

- Coloured A3 paper
- White paper
- Glue such as Creall Coll
- Glow-in-the-dark paint such as Creall Glow
- Wax crayons such as Creall Waxy

#### WHAT WILL YOU BE DOING?

You paint a volcano.






#### STEP 1

Can you name a volcano? And do you know how it works?

You will receive a piece of white and a piece of coloured paper.





#### STEP 2

Draw the outline of your volcano on the coloured paper. Next, cut the volcano open from the bottom to the top. Fold the sides of the cut pieces.



#### STEP 3

Stick the white sheet behind the cut piece with glue. Next, draw the inside of your volcano on the white piece. Draw the magma hearth, the crater and maybe some old craters and old ash layers.




#### STEP 4

Use the glow-in-the-dark paint to paint the magma inside the volcano. What happens if there is a volcanic eruption? Paint that too.
