MATERIALS

- · Firm, white paper
- Toilet rolls
- Fingerpaint, like Creall Fingerpaint
- Adhesive tape

LEARNING OBJECTIVE

Saying and learning to write letters and learning how they sound.



HEARTS FOR YOU

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Tape the corners of the paper to the table. Have every student think of someone they will be making the artwork for. The children will pick two colours that fit that person.



The students will use their hands to paint the base with the two colours they chose.



Next, they will make heart shapes will toilet rolls. They will push one side of the edge carefully inwards. They should flatten the other side slightly, so they get a pointy end. Have them stamp their paper full of hearts.



The children will pick another colour to write who the art is for, for example 'mum'. They can also write the letters inside the hearts.
