

MATERIALS

- Blank envelopes
- Piece of cardboard
- Gouache like Creall Color+
- Brushes such as Creall Gussow or Creall Trixi brush
- A4 paper

LEARNING OBJECTIVE

Writing a narrative text (here: a letter).



WRITE A LETTER

1



Give the students an envelope that they paint at their own discretion. To prevent the paint from penetrating, you may put a piece of cardboard in the envelope.

2



Distribute the A4 papers as well. This is converted by the students into stationery, for example, by decorating the edges or adding their own 'logos'.

3



Explain what the layout and order of a letter look like. If the stationery is dry, the students write their letters. Let them choose for whom they write it and what they write about.

4



When the letter is ready, the students give the letter to the addressee. Alternatively, they can also take the letter home and send it to the addressee from there.
