LEARNING OBJECTIVE

Consciously dealing with one's own views and expressing them understandably for others. Giving a (small) speech with your own opinion and arguments.



YOUR OPINION IN PICTURES

1



Prepare one or more statements. You can also link it to a current theme. Write (one of) the statement(s) on the board.

2



Students decide whether they are for or against. Then they make their opinion and main argument concrete by painting it on the cardboard.

3



When the signs are ready, you can vote: who is for and who is against? Let the for and against voters form duos. The students show each other their plates.

4



Let the students start the conversation on the basis of the signs: can they see why the other person is for or against? Do they understand his or her point of view?
